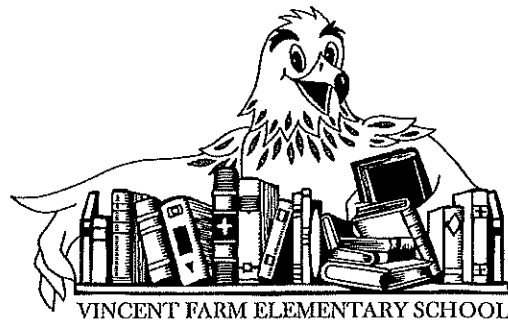


PreKindergarten Supply List



The following lists are supply items that will likely be needed by the student during the school year:

- **A backpack to be worn to school daily.** (Please choose one that is large enough to carry a folder. No mini backpacks. Make sure your child can open and close it independently, has no wheels, and it can be worn over both shoulders.)
- **A bag of extra clothing to be kept at school** (seasonally appropriate) to be kept in their cubby in case of emergencies. Please label all items with child's name.
- **1 plastic pocket folder** (any solid color no prongs)
- **12 white glue sticks**
- **1 box of crayons** (16 or 24 count regular size not thick crayons)
- **1 recent photograph of your child** (child's name written on back of photograph)

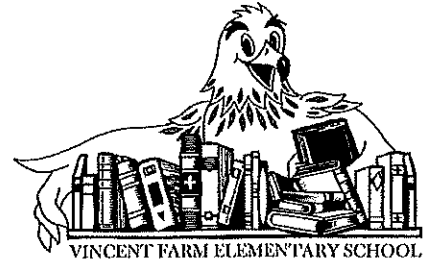
Families may donate the following school supplies:

- 1 set of headphones (not wireless/no earbuds) Labeled with your child's name.

The following items do not need to be labeled with your child's name:

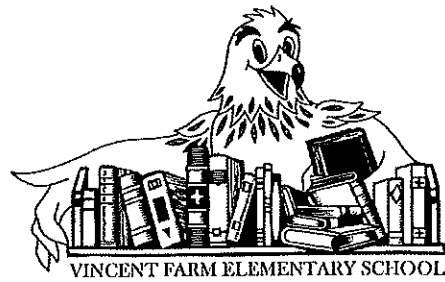
- 8 packs of Crayola crayons (24 count)

- 4 packs of washable markers (2 pack classic, 2 pack other colors)
- 2 packs of thin, black dry erase markers
- 2 highlighters
- 1 set of Crayola watercolors

Families may donate the following school supplies:

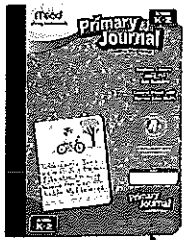
- Ziploc bags (snack, sandwich, quart and gallon sizes)

The following lists are supply items that will likely be needed by the student during the first half of the school year:

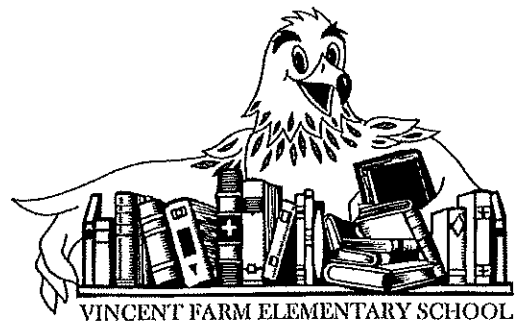


- 2 boxes of 16 crayons
- 24 pre-sharpened #2 pencils (yellow please)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 1 large school supply ZIPPER pouch-label name (no supply boxes)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1" white binder with clear view cover and inside pockets
- 1 set of 5 tab dividers w/ colored tabs -Please LABEL each tab with the following: Songs/Poems, Fluency, Strategies, Math, Bingo Boards
- 18 solid glue sticks
- 2 PRIMARY notebooks (space for picture at top, lines on bottom) No spirals please-label name (sold at Amazon, Walmart, Target)
- 1 composition notebook (black and white and all lines)
- 1 pack of pencil top erasers
- 2 plastic folders with pockets
- 1 art smock (an old or oversized t-shirt will do)-label name
- **A bag of extra clothing to be kept at school.** (This will be used in case of a bathroom accident or spilled milk/juice. Please make certain that the bag, and all clothing, is marked with your child's name.)

The following lists are supply items that will likely be needed by the student during the first half of school year:

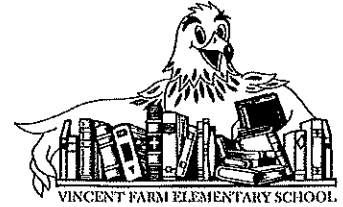
- 2 highlighters

- 1 pack of 5 tab dividers
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1½" binder-clear view cover with pockets (This must be 1½" because it will be the student's "Study Buddy".) - no zipper binders
- 3 marble composition books with wide ruled paper
- 4 dry erase markers (black)
- Headphones or earbuds

The following lists are supply items that will likely be needed by the student during the school year:

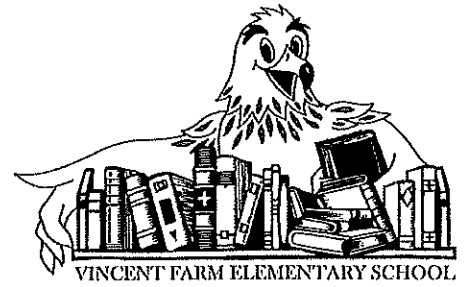
- 6 composition notebooks (2 black, 2 red, green, blue)

- 1- 3-inch (3") 3-ring binder with dividers (all subjects)

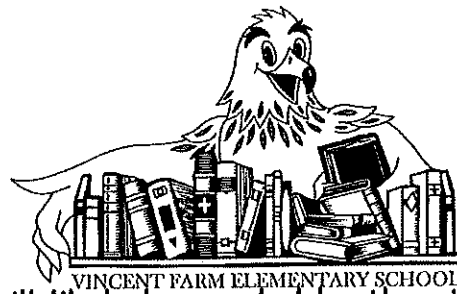

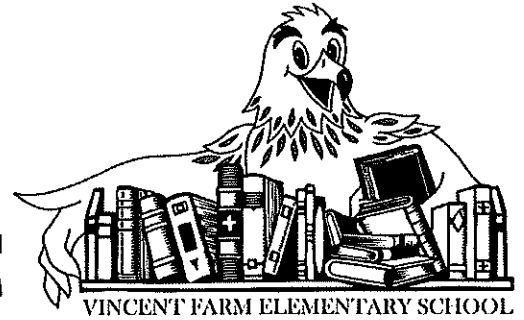
